



Snoqualmie Cowl

Finished Measurements

20" diameter, 9" tall

Yarn

HPKY (Hand Painted Knitting Yarns) Rome, in Dark Gray, Light Gray and White, less than 1 Skein each, or other bulky yarn.

Needles

US 10 16" circular needle

Notions

Stitch Marker
Scissors
Yarn needle

Gauge

16 sts and 25 rows=4" in cable pattern, blocked

This simple cowl is perfect for using up small amounts of ultra-luxurious HPKY, or other the lovely bulky yarn you haven't been able to throw away. Worked in the round from the bottom up, this project knits up in moments, and is a great way to practice simple cables. Try different color combinations and stripe patterns for a variety of striking designs using the same simple pattern.

Cable Pattern

Round 1: (K3, p1) around

Round 2: (K3, p1) around

Round 3: (Slp 2 sts to cable needle, hold in back, k 1,
k the 2 sts from cable needle, p1) around

Round 4: (K3, p1) around

Directions

With Dark Gray CO 80. PM to mark beginning of rnd, and prepare to work in the round.

Work Cable Pattern rnds 1-4 4 times.

Break yarn, join Light Gray. Work Cable Pattern rnds 1-4 8 times.

Break yarn, join White. Work Cable Pattern rnds 1-4 2 times.

Finishing

BO loosely in pattern and weave in any ends. Block to measurements.
